Equipment/Materials

Students should set up their internet-connected computer or device in a well-lit room with the camera positioned to capture their **full body**. A smooth flooring surface (e.g. wood/laminate/tile) is recommended, and a barre, chair, or countertop can be used for support during ballet classes.

Dress Code

Leotard or fitted activewear; socks or ballet shoes; hair neatly secured off face and neck.

Grading Policy

While progress is monitored daily, grades are entered into Powerschool at the end of each quarter. During distance-learning dance majors will be graded using the following rubric and categories:
